POOL UPDATE

Pool Update:

We had another successful pool fundraising event on Saturday, March 2nd with our Monte Carlo night. We raised over \$2800 with our casino games and live/silent auction. Currently, our total pool fundraising account has reached almost \$7000.

Thank you to all who donated items, volunteered their time and/or supported the event by attending. In addition, it was a great revenue night for Wahkonsa with food and drink sales on a cold winter night.

The below excerpt was taken from the email sent by our President, Jon Sievers, last week and serves as an update.

1. The Board is analyzing all aspects of the pool and has taken no formal action. This includes any action to open the pool by a certain date (e.g., June 1st) or the creation of specific membership packages or fees for use of the pool.
2. The Board believes that a special election of the membership is needed to reopen the pool and any proposed re-opening of the pool is dependent on the outcome of this election.
3. The Board supports the Pool Committee's fundraising efforts and its due diligence assessment on re-opening the pool.
4. While we have received very positive feedback on re-opening the pool; we have not received feedback from all members. The Board and the Pool Committee will continue to solicit input from Wahkonsa Members. Please continue to send us your comments or questions.
