Painting will also begin next week- this needs to be completed, no matter what, to help visually improve this space to our members and visitors this summer. One area of opportunity which remains, is assessing the pumps and working conditions of the pumphouse. It has been a challenge getting our current vendor to schedule a time to come on-site again with weather and so many other area pools opening over the Memorial Day weekend. They did a general assessment two years ago and all was working at that point in time.
